

Donor and Surrogacy Treatment Fees

Prices effective from 1 April 2019

Donor and surrogacy fees are charged in addition to treatment fees. Please refer to the Treatment Fees guide to determine the cost of treatment using a donor or surrogate.

Donor Addition fees include: Semen analysis (male), AMH test (female), blood tests for infectious diseases and saliva test for three commonly inherited genetic conditions: Cystic Fibrosis, Fragile X Syndrome and Spinal Muscular Atrophy; medical consultation(s) for the donor and counselling for the donor and recipient.

Medical Consultations:

- Egg donors and surrogates receive two medical consultations, one prior to treatment and one following.
- Sperm donors receive one medical consultation.

Counselling Consultations:

- All donors, surrogates and intending parent(s) attend at least one counselling consultation each.
- Up to three counselling consultations are included in the donor or surrogacy addition fee. There is no refund if you use less than three consultations.
- Additional counselling consultations are paid by the intending parent(s).

Additional donors: A "work-up" fee will apply if you are using a personal egg or sperm donor or surrogate; and would like to screen more than one potential party.

Charged per cycle: Please note donor and surrogacy addition and donor reimbursement fees are charged per cycle, at the time of treatment, not per donor or surrogate.

Treatment using donor sperm

Sperm donor addition

Cost per cycle, in addition to treatment fees

IUI cycle using clinic or personal sperm donor	\$1,500
IVF cycle using clinic or personal sperm donor, including ICSI	\$3,500
Additional sperm donor work-up fee	\$1,500

Treatment using donor eggs

Egg donor addition

Cost per cycle, in addition to treatment fees

IVF Cycle using a clinic or personal egg donor	\$4,820
Donor reimbursement	\$1,650
Additional egg donor work-up fee	\$1,500
Guaranteed embryo transfer*	\$990

* Guaranteed embryo transfer. Intending parent(s) using an egg donor can elect to pay an additional fee to gain assurance that they will have at least one embryo to transfer. If there are no embryos suitable to transfer, the intending parent(s) will receive a refund of \$10,000. Eligibility criteria applies to the intending parent(s) and the egg donor. Donor reimbursement

Donor reimbursement aims to ensure that donors are not financially disadvantaged as a result of undergoing treatment
 Donors are reimbursed a fixed amount irrespective of actual costs incurred
 Expenses such as mileage to get to and from the clinic for appointments, car parking and child care are covered by the fee

Recipient information

Recipients pay a donor reimbursement to the clinic when the donor begins treatment
 The clinic will pass the full amount to the donor at egg collection
 Donor reimbursement applies irrespective of the outcome of the donor's cycle
 Donor reimbursement applies to all recipients, whether using a clinic or personal donor; and whether treatment is privately or publicly funded
 Donor reimbursement is not paid by the Ministry of Health. You are personally liable for this cost
 Donors may elect to forgo reimbursement. Coercion to encourage a donor to forgo reimbursement is strictly prohibited

Potential additional cost

If the donor lives out of town, necessitating flights and accommodation whilst undergoing treatment, these costs will be in addition to the donor reimbursement fee
 If the donor requires an anaesthetist for heavier sedation, this cost will be in addition to other charges
 ECART is required when having treatment with both egg AND sperm donors and donations between certain family members
