Payment timing

Consultation

To be paid on the day of appointment.

Pre-treatment and storage

To be paid within 14 days of invoice.

Non-IVF treatment

Treatment cycles are invoiced on Day 1 of treatment and the account is to be paid prior to insemination (IUI) or scan (Ovulation Induction).

IVF Fees

Three clear stages

Our IVF costs are split across three clear stages, and include medication.

Medication included

Your doctor will select the best medication dosage to suit your needs.

Stage 1.+2.

All medication to get you through to and including egg collection is included at Stage 1.

Please note: It's possible that you may require additional medication - your medical team will let you know if this applies to you.

Medication

Your doctor will determine your dose of medication as part of your personalised treatment plan.

Medications cannot be refunded once they have been issued to you.

IVF – Payment options

You will be invoiced at each of the 3 stages.

For your convenience we have three ways in which you can pay for your IVF treatment.

1. Staged payment

Stage 1. Medication and monitoring – invoiced when your individualised treatment plan is confirmed and must be paid before medication can be issued.

Stage 2. Egg collection and embryology – due to be paid before egg collection.

Stage 3. Embryo transfer – invoiced on the day of transfer. Payment is required on the same day.

2. Pre-payment: pay upfront

You can pay upfront for Stages 1, 2 and 3 as per your estimate. We will refund any overpayment or invoice additional costs at the end of your cycle.

3. Fertility cover

Pay a single up-front fee covering up to three cycles of IVF over an 18 month period. If treatment does not result in a live birth after the three cycles, you will receive a 70% refund.*
