



## Sperm donor addition

The donor addition fee is to access either a clinic or a personal donor.

### DONOR ADDITION

#### CLINIC AND PERSONAL DONORS

This fee is additional to IVF and IUI treatment.

IUI - Sperm donor addition	(per cycle) \$1,500
IVF - Sperm donor addition	(per cycle) \$3,500

Please note: IUI and IVF treatment fees are additional

Donor addition fee includes:

- **Screening tests for sperm quality:** semen analysis, SCSA for DNA fragmentation, strict sperm morphology and trial wash.
- **ICSI:** Sperm Microinjection as required.
- **Genetic screening:** all Fertility Associates clinic recruited donors are screened for three commonly inherited genetic conditions; Cystic Fibrosis, Fragile X Syndrome and Spinal Muscular Atrophy. Donors are also screened for infectious diseases.
- **Donor preparation:** initial medical and counselling consultations for the donor.

<b>Possible extras</b>	Personal donors: a screening fee will apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• for more than one donor</li> <li>• if you do not proceed to treatment with your personal donor.</li> </ul>
<b>Invoice timing</b>	Before collecting first medication or at Day 1.
<b>Payment timing</b>	Donor addition is part of Stage 1 which is due for payment when collecting medication (IVF) or before insemination (IUI).
<b>Counselling</b>	One individual counselling consultation is required for all donors and intending parents 'recipients'. The first counselling consultation for the donor is included in the donor addition fee, along with joint counselling. The first recipient counselling consultation is an additional fee and invoiced per counselling consultation. <p>Additional counselling (per consultation)      \$170</p>

### Treatment with frozen eggs and a clinic sperm donor

<b>Embryo transfer with frozen eggs</b>	Includes: Egg thawing, ICSI & fresh embryo transfer Additional: Medications \$5,500
<b>Clinic Sperm Donor Addition fee</b>	Includes all of the above as for IVF Sperm donor addition fee Excludes ICSI as this is included in the egg thawing and transfer fee \$1,135



## Egg donor addition fees

From April 2020

The donor addition fee is to access either a clinic or a personal donor. Please refer to Fertility Associates egg donor information sheet for further details.

### DONOR ADDITION

#### ONE-TO-ONE AND PERSONAL DONORS

This fee is additional to treatment fees and is applied at Stage 1. of treatment.

<b>Donor addition</b>	\$4,820
<b>Includes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Donor screening tests, medications, consultations. Recruitment for clinic donors.</li> <li>• One individual counselling consultation is required for all donors and intending parents 'recipients'. The first counselling consultation for the donor is included in the donor addition fee, along with joint counselling. The first recipient counselling consultation is an additional fee and invoiced per counselling consultation.</li> </ul>
<b>Possible extras</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Additional counselling consultations      \$170</li> <li>• Guaranteed Embryo Fee      \$990 This is an optional addition for clinic recruited donors. If there are no embryos suitable to transfer, the intending parent(s) receive a refund of \$10,000. Eligibility criteria applies.</li> <li>• Subsequent cycle with the same donor A fee may apply.</li> </ul>

**Donor reimbursement fee**      \$1,650

- This fee is separate to the donor addition fee.
- The clinic passes on the full reimbursement to the donor at the time of egg collection.
- Donor reimbursement applies irrespective of the outcome of the donor's cycle.

#### Donor addition + Reimbursement fee

<b>Invoice timing</b>	Before donor collects first medication.
<b>Payment timing</b>	This fee is due when or before the donor collects medication.



### DONOR REIMBURSEMENT - ALL DONORS

- The reimbursement applies to all recipients, whether using a clinic or personal donor, and whether the treatment is private or publicly funded.
- Recipients pay the donor reimbursement when the donor starts her treatment cycle.
- Personal donors may elect to forgo reimbursement - this would need to be agreed in advance on a 'case by case' basis between the clinic and the donor.
- The standard reimbursement covers typical expenses such as parking, childcare, time and inconvenience. If the donor lives out of town and requires air fares and accommodation, these expenses will require extra reimbursement.

### FA EGG BANK

This fee is an all inclusive fee with a Guarantee to Embryo Transfer.

<b>FA Egg Bank Donor inclusive fee</b>	\$17,400
<b>Includes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use of donor eggs - recruitment, preparation and donor cycle</li> <li>• Embryo creation and ICSI</li> <li>• Recipient preparation, medication and frozen embryo transfer</li> <li>• Donor reimbursement</li> <li>• Counselling consultations (2 included)</li> <li>• Guarantee Embryo to Transfer provides at least one blastocyst to transfer or \$10,000 refund. Eligibility criteria and terms apply.</li> <li>• Sperm freeze and shipping</li> </ul>
<b>Invoice timing</b>	As donor is allocated.
<b>Payment timing</b>	Before eggs are thawed.

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# Surrogacy & ECART



## Good to know

### SURROGACY ADDITION

This fee is additional to embryo transfer fee.

Preparation of surrogate, including screening, two medical consultations (before and after treatment) and counselling. This is prior to embryo transfer commencing.	\$2,455
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#### Same surrogate

Coordination of subsequent transfers with the same surrogate. A fee may apply.

#### Additional surrogate

Screening and preparation of additional potential surrogates, charged per surrogate screened.	\$1,500
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#### Possible extras

If the surrogate does not proceed to embryo transfer a screening fee will apply.	\$1,500
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<b>Invoice timing</b>	Before surrogate treatment commences
<b>Payment timing</b>	Before surrogate collects medication for embryo replacement

### 'ECART' APPROVAL

Ethics Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology

ECART is required for some treatment including:

- Donor egg and donor sperm together
- Donor embryo
- Surrogacy
- Donation between certain family members

All applications to ECART incur an application fee.

*Public Funding note: The Ministry of Health does not cover the ECART fee, publicly funded patients are liable to pay the ECART fee.*

<b>Ethical Applications Fee</b>	\$3,090
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<b>Includes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Documentation: our costs to prepare reports, compile documents and submit applications.</li> <li>• Counselling and guidance throughout the process: Each party to the ECART application will be required to attend at least two counselling consultations. The cost of the intending parents counselling consultations is included in your ECART application. (Donor or surrogate counselling is included in the "counselling").</li> </ul>
<b>Invoice timing</b>	When all parties are confirmed to start ECART workup (doctor appointments, counselling, screening etc) prior to meeting with the ECART committee.
<b>Possible extras</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Intending parents and surrogates may require additional medical assessments. Your counsellor or fertility doctor will advise.</li> </ul> <p>Please note: Donors and surrogates are required to have medical assessments with one of our fertility doctors - this is included in their addition fees.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Legal fees are not included: Treatment involving surrogacy and donor embryos requires each party to obtain independent legal advice.</li> </ul>
<b>Timing</b>	The ECART application process typically takes 4-6 months as the Committee only meets 6 times per annum.



### PAYMENT

Prices are in NZ dollars and include GST. Prices may be subject to change without further notice.

Payment can be made by cash, cheque, direct debit, credit card or Q Card.
